To: The Managerial Authorities of Recognised Primary, Secondary, Community and Comprehensive Schools and the Chief Executives of Education and Training Boards

Revision of Teacher Salaries under Building Momentum - A New Public Service Agreement 2021-2023 ("The Agreement")

Application of pay adjustments due on 1 October 2023

Introduction

- The Minister for Education wishes to inform managerial authorities and teachers of revised rates of salary and allowances for teachers as provided for in "Building Momentum - A New Public Service Agreement 2021-2023" as reviewed.
- 2. This circular sets out the increases to pay due on 1 October 2023 as provided for under The Agreement.

Salary Increases to be implemented under Building Momentum

- 3. Following the review of Building Momentum, a 1.5% (or €750, whichever is greater) pay adjustment was agreed and will be implemented with effect from 1 October 2023.
- 4. In accordance with Section 3.1 of the Building Momentum Agreement, whole-time annual basic scale salaries will be increased by 1.5% (or €750, whichever is greater) with effect from 1 October 2023.
- 5. The revised pay scales due from 1 October 2023 for primary teachers are set out at Appendix 1 (a) and (b). The revised pay scales due from 1 October 2023 for post- primary teachers are set out at Appendix 1 (c) and (d).
- 6. The revisions to casual daily/hourly part-time rates due on 1 October 2023 are set out at Appendix 3.
- 7. All salary scales and daily/hourly casual and non-casual rates payable to teachers set out in previous Circulars are superseded by the terms of this Circular with effect from 1 October 2023.

Allowances

- 8. The Agreement also provides for increases to allowances in the nature of pay of 1.5% from 1 October 2023. Allowances which are calculated as a specific percentage or specified portion of basic pay should be calculated by reference to the revised rates of pay with in effect from 1 October 2023.
- 9. The revisions to Qualification Allowances for teachers who entered teaching between 1 January 2011 and 31 January 2012 are set out in Appendix 2 (a) with effect from 1 October 2023.
- 10. The revisions to Qualification allowances for teachers who entered teaching prior to 1 January 2011 are set out at Appendix 2 (b) with effect from 1 October 2023.
- 11. Increases to Other Allowances are set out at Appendix 4 with effect from 1 October 2023.
- 12. It should be noted that certain allowances for new beneficiaries were abolished with effect from 1 February 2012 and their appearance in the attached pay scales does not confer an entitlement to the allowance where the staff member was not already entitled to the allowance. Please read in association with Circular 0008/2013 Public Service-Wide Review of Allowances and Premium Payments on current allowance entitlements.
- 13. Overpayments will be dealt with in accordance with the relevant Department Circulars.

Pensions in payment

- 14. The principle of pay parity in pension increases for pre-existing schemes has been agreed up to the end of 2023, in line with the amended agreement under Building Momentum. Increases should be passed on to pensions in line with that policy.
- 15. For further guidance, or to determine if a historic increase is due to pensions in payment for pre-existing schemes, please refer to Department of Public Expenditure NDP Delivery and Reform Circulars 20/2017, 02/2018, 19/2019, 10/2021, 19/2022 and 02/2023. Queries with regard to the Department of Public Expenditure NDP Delivery and Reform Circulars circulars should be addressed to pensions@per.gov.ie.
- 16. Single Public Service Pension Scheme ('Single Scheme') pensions are uprated inline with the Consumer Price Index (CPI), subject to a separate instruction from the Department of Public Expenditure NDP Delivery and Reform. Therefore, Single Scheme pensions in payment in respect of former public servants who served in grades to which this circular applies, will not be adjusted with reference to the revisions of basic pay set out in Section 3.
