**Revision of Teacher Salaries under  
Building Momentum - A New Public Service Agreement 2021-2022  
("The Agreement")**

**Application of pay adjustments due on 2 February 2022 and 1 October 2022**

**Introduction**

1. The Minister for Education wishes to inform Managerial Authorities and Teachers of revised rates of salary and allowances for Teachers as provided for in "Building Momentum - A New Public Service Agreement 2021-2022" as reviewed.
2. This circular sets out the increases pay due from 2 February 2022 as an amendment to The Agreement and the pay increases due on 1 October 2022 as provided for under The Agreement.

**Salary Increases to be implemented under Building Momentum**

3. Following the review of Building Momentum, a 3% pay adjustment was agreed and will be implemented with effect from 2 February 2022.
4. In accordance with Section 3 of Building Momentum, whole-time annual basic scale salaries will be increased by 1% or €500, whichever is greater, with effect from 1 October 2022.
5. Increases to pay scales due from 2 February 2022 and on 1 October 2022 for Primary teachers are set out at Appendix 1 (a) and (b). Increases to pay scales due from 2 February 2022 and on 1 October 2022 for Post Primary teachers are set out at Appendix 1 (c) and (d).
6. Increases to casual daily/hourly part-time rates due from 2 February 2022 and on 1 October 2022 are set out at Appendix 3.
7. All salary scales and daily/hourly casual and non-casual rates payable to teachers set out in previous Circulars are superseded by the terms of this Circular with effect from 2 February 2022 and 1 October 2022.

## Allowances

8. The Agreement also provides for increases to allowances in the nature of pay of 3% from 2 February 2022 and 1% from 1 October 2022. Allowances which are calculated as a specific percentage or specified portion of basic pay should be calculated by reference to the revised rates of pay with in effect from 2 February 2022 and 1 October 2022.
9. Increases to Qualification Allowances for teachers who entered teaching between 1 January 2011 and 31 January 2012 are set out in Appendix 2 (a) with effect from 2 February 2022 and 1 October 2022.
10. Increases to Qualification allowances for teachers who entered teaching prior to 1 January 2011 are set out at Appendix 2 (b) with effect from 2 February 2022 and 1 October 2022.
11. Increases to Other Allowances are set out at Appendix 4 with effect from 2 February 2022 and 1 October 2022.
12. It should be noted that certain allowances for new beneficiaries were abolished with effect from 1 February 2012 and their appearance in the attached pay scales does not confer an entitlement to the allowance where the staff member was not already entitled to the allowance. Please read in association with [Circular 0008/2013 Public Service-Wide Review of Allowances and Premium Payments](#) on current allowance entitlements.
13. Overpayments will be dealt with in accordance with the relevant Department Circulars.

## Pensions in payment

14. The principle of pay parity has been agreed up to the end of 2023 in line with the amended agreement under Building Momentum. To determine if an increase is due to pensions in payment, under pre-existing pension schemes, up to end 2022, please refer to the detailed guidance contained in DPER Circulars 20/2017, 02/2018, 19/2019 and 10/2021. 15. Single Public Service Pension Scheme ('Single Scheme') pensions are uprated in-line with the Consumer Price Index (CPI). Therefore pensions in payment in respect of former public servants who served in grades to which this circular applies, will not be adjusted with reference to the revisions of basic pay set out in Section 3.

## Calculation of arrears to pensions in payment

16. Further information to pension authorities on how to implement these arrears can be found in DPER [Circular 19/2022](#) and any queries arising should be made directly [pensions@per.gov.ie](mailto:pensions@per.gov.ie).

17. The Pensions of those who are members of a pre-existing public service pension scheme (Non-Single Scheme) which are in payment between 2 February 2022 and 1 October 2022, will be adjusted as appropriate in the normal way, by reference to the revisions of basic pay set out in section 3 of this Circular.
18. The lump sums of staff to which this Circular applies who retired on or after 2 February 2022 will be revised by reference to the revisions of basic pay set out in Section 3 as appropriate.
19. The lump sum of officers in the grades to which this circular applies who retired before 2 February 2022 should not be adjusted.
20. For Single Scheme retirees who were working as public servants on the dates of the revision of basic pay (i.e. 2 February 2022 and/or 1 July 2022 and/or 1 October 2022) and subsequently retired in the period from 2 February 2022 to 1 October 2022, their referable amounts accrued and contribution deductions owed will be re-calculated. Lump sum and pensions paid will then be adjusted, as appropriate.
21. Final Retirement Benefit Statements and Leaver Statements for Single Scheme members for staff to whom this circular applies, who were working as public servants on the dates of the revision of basic pay and who subsequently retired or left their respective Relevant Authority may also have to be adjusted, as appropriate.
