- Controlling excessive bureaucratic and initiative overload in our schools and colleges
- Restoration of pre-2009 pupil teacher ratios
- Urgent addressing of the national skills shortage
- Resolution of the contractual situation of tutors in Adult Education
- Recognition of the teaching carried out by Youthreach Resource Persons
- Ensuring compliance with the TUI, DES, THEA May 2017 Agreement
- Underfunding of the third level sector
- Ensuring a more efficient, effective and professionally-run TUI Annual Congress
