Changes to the Career Break Scheme for Registered Teachers employed in Recognised Primary and Post Primary Schools - 2020/21 School Year

1. Introduction

- 1.1 In response to issues raised in relation to teacher supply, certain restrictions imposed in the Career Break Scheme have been suspended for the past number of school years. You are advised that these restrictions are also suspended for the 2020/21 school year.
- 1.2 A teacher who is on a Career Break may now be employed, in a substitute capacity only, without the restrictions imposed in the <u>Career Break Scheme</u> as contained in Chapter 7 (Paragraph 8.1) of Circular 54/2019.

2. Pay Arrangements

2.1 A teacher who is on career break and is employed in a substitute capacity will be paid at the same rate as a regular substitute.
